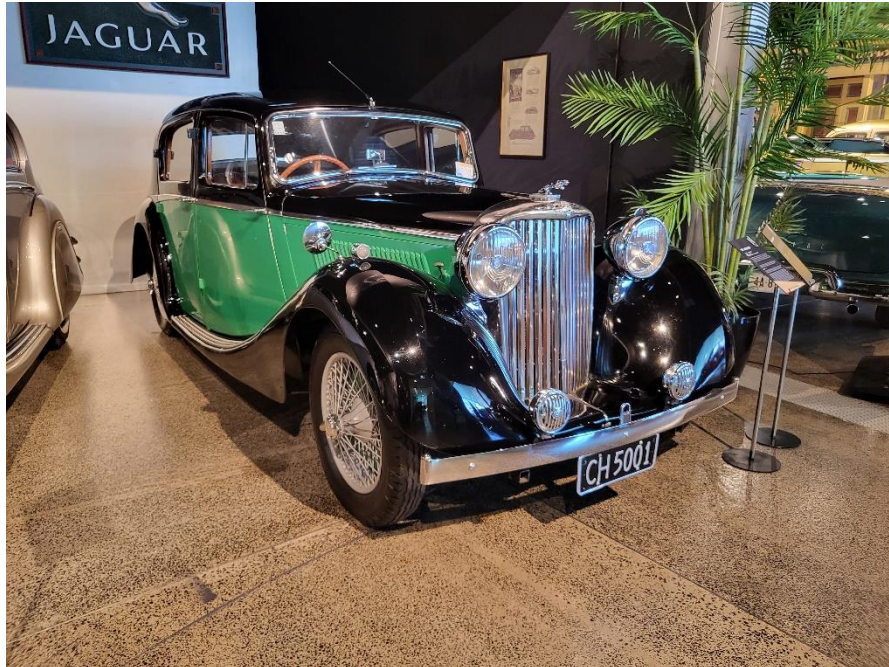

THE WORLDS FASTEST INDIAN

On a recent trip to New Zealand Kathy and I circumnavigated the South Island. Apart from the breath-taking scenery around every bend the island is home to many car museums. It seems that after WW2 New Zealand's currency had a low value so importing motor vehicles was very expensive. This resulted in older cars remaining in service for many years and their owners becoming adept at keeping them going. In the 1960s NZ was assembling CKD cars from the UK at Nelson. The site of that assembly plant is now home to an extraordinary privately owned motor museum with its own restoration workshop and carpentry shop. This is no shed full of rusty relics, all the cars are restored to a very high standard and presented beautifully with not a speck of dust in sight.

In the far south of the Island is the unassuming town of Invercargill, home of motorcycle enthusiast Bert Munro. Bert was a talented mechanical engineer who liked to build very fast motorbikes. E Hayes & Sons hardware store(a fully functioning business) houses Bert's record breaking 1920

Indian Scout along with memorabilia from Bert's workshop. Bert's amazing story is the subject of a very entertaining movie starring Anthony Hopkins, "The World's Fastest Indian". The store also houses a very large collection of bikes, cars and other machinery.

Unfortunately my phone died recently and many of the photos I took in NZ were lost including those from Invercargill.
